- \$8,604.89 check in the operating account should have come out of the construction account. Balances will be adjusted.
- Robert made the motion to approve the Treasurer's report and was seconded by Morgan. Motion carried.

Chief's Report:

- 4490 has alternator whine. Monitoring it for now.
- Bandera VFD October 19 fundraiser. They want a team for competition.
- Adam lead discussion about relocated the fuel depot near the tree behind the station and replacing the tanks with 300 gallon ground level tanks with pumps. They would be powered by battery and solar. Robert made the motion. Adam will spearhead the project.
- TPWD location will be the same. We will have TPWD change the traffic pattern to go up the road west of the church.
- We decided to have electronic keypad doors on the fire station.

- We will look into adding keypad door lock and electric upgrades to the RH station.
- KIMCO was testing the masks and air supply systems.
- Once we move to new station we will do truck inventory and assign responsibilities.

President's Report:

- Need a nominating committee for the Board positions.
- Mark will look into the cost of rebuilding the marquee sign. We will replace the tires. Might require wheels and a new axle.
- We need a Board meeting to do a budget. Mark will arrange the meeting.

Old Business:
